## Why Should We Go to Mass?

Going to the Holy mass sounds boring, but visiting and celebrating the Holy Mass is the best thing you can do for your soul.

Christ makes himself present through a unique charism the priest has been given through the sacrament of holy orders. Third, the Lord is present in the Eucharist *in the Word of God*. Some describe the Protestant Church as the church of the Bible and the Catholic Church as the church of ritual. This is certainly not the case.

We should go to the Holy Mass because we have to hear God's word. Also we have to visit Jesus, that make Him happy; talk to Jesus about private things is another reason why should we go to Mass. Other reason why should we go is because we have to be a good Christian influence to our posterity and family.

In the Holy Mass we can learn about Jesus's life, and that's good for our soul. That's why I think it's good to go celebrate the Holy Mass.
