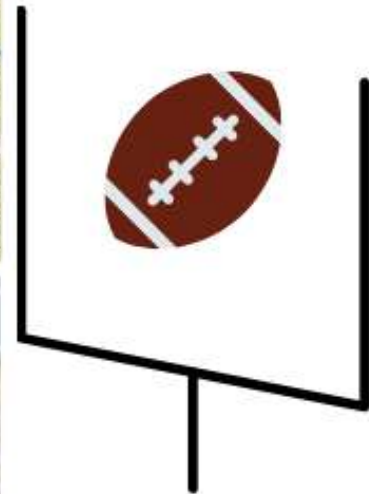
MAY THEIR MEMORY LIVE FOREVER.



Our 7th graders recently read the novel *Night*, by noble prize winner, Elie Wiesel which recounts his and his families' harrowing journey in the Nazi concentration camps of the Holocaust. The lesson prompted our students and teachers to visit our local Holocaust Memorial in Miami Beach. They learned more about Holocaust and the beautiful stone and bronze sculpture created by Kenneth Treister as a memorial to Jewish culture and the 6 million lives lost in the Holocaust. They had the opportunity to listen first-hand to the moving true story of Judy Rodin, a Holocaust child survivor herself. Their fieldtrip was emotional and poignant and a lesson that they will never forget.

Scholarships for Florida Schoolchildren



It's Time To Apply! Step Up For Students 2024 - 2025

Renewal Scholarship Students

Families with children that were already enrolled in the Step Up For Students program, may now RENEW their student's Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities, Florida Tax Credit Scholarship, or Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options for the 2024-2025 school year. As a reminder, current families who would like to renew their student's scholarship must complete the Step Up For Students application annually. For instructions on how to renew your student's scholarship, check your email or login to your Step Up For Students portal.

New Scholarship Applicants

Families may now apply for a 2024-25 scholarship for the following programs:

- Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC)*
- Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO)*
- Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA)

*With recently passed legislation, if signed by the Governor, the Hope Scholarship will merge with the FTC and FES-EO programs. Families who are benefiting from the Hope Scholarship for the 2023-24 school year will apply through the FTC/FES-EO programs to renew their student's scholarship for the 2024-25 school year.
